- A visit was organized for our students to a nearby Anganwadi during Diwali. They helped the little children create different crafts to decorate their Anganwadi and celebrated the festival of lights with a lot of fervour, joy and other enjoyable activities.

The school also designs and supports initiatives that instills in the child accountability, clarity of purpose and a sense of moral responsibility towards social and environmental causes.


Students of our school joined hands to reach out to the community and persuade for the cause of 'Water' - the elixir of life.
